This IFRA certificate is compliant with the requirements set out in Regulation (EU) 2023/1545 amending Annexes II, III, and V of Regulation (EC) No 1223/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council on cosmetic products.

The IFRA Standards regarding use restriction are based on safety assessments by the panel of experts of the RESEARCH INSTITUTE FOR FRAGRANCE MATERIALS (RIFM) and are enforced by the IFRA Scientific Committee.

Evaluation of individual fragrance ingredients is made according to the safety standards contained in the relevant section of the IFRA Code of Practice. It is the ultimate responsibility of the customer to ensure the safety of the final product (containing this raw material) by further testing if needed. For essential oils, percentages of restricted substances are determined according to gas chromatography data (level detection is 100 ppm). For compositions, percentages of restricted substances are determined by calculations from raw materials of the blend.

For other raw materials (isolates, absolutes,...), percentages of restricted substances are determined from suppliers information.
